2023-24 SCHEDULE OF TUITION AND FEES

Tuition schedule approved by the Silverwood School Board of Trustees in January 2023 for 2023-2024.

TUITION \$ 14,500 per student

PAYMENT OPTIONS

To secure a place in the upcoming academic year, Silverwood requires a \$500 non-refundable tuition deposit, due on or before February 3, 2023. This deposit is credited towards tuition. To pay the remaining tuition balance, Silverwood offers two payment options:

Option A : one-time	1 payment of the balance \$14,000 due on August 15, 2023.
Option B : monthly	10 monthly payments of \$1,400 due starting August 15, 2023 through May 15, 2024.

PAID IN FULL DISCOUNT

A 2% tuition discount is applied to all accounts paid in full via check by July 31, 2023.

FINANCIAL AID

Silverwood also offers Financial Aid for families who demonstrate need. Silverwood uses SSS to determine family need. For more information, visit: *silverwood.school/tuition-finaid*.

ADDITIONAL FEES

Application Fee:	\$75 non-refundable payment per student, due with new student application.
Technology Fee:	\$500 one-time, per-student payment for new students new (due with initial Tuition payment in August.)
Late Fee:	Accounts more than 10 days past due will be charged a \$25 late fee. Accounts more than 30 days past due will be charged and additional \$25 for each day the account remains in arrears.
NSF Fee:	A \$25 fee will be assessed for each NSF returned check.
Credit / Debit Card Fee:	A 3% surcharge will be applied to any credit card transaction.

DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

If an account balance is overdue, Silverwood reserves the right to withhold the Student's school records. If payments are not made when due, Silverwood may declare the entire amount of all unpaid tuition due immediately. If it becomes necessary for Silverwood to enforce this agreement, the Parents will be liable to the school for all fees, costs, and expenses of any kind incurred with or without suit, including but not limited to legal fees, all costs of court and public officials, and reasonable compensation for efforts conducted by Silverwood's employees or agents. A student may not be considered for re-enrollment unless all previous charges on their account have been paid in full. A persistently delinquent account may result in disenrollment of the Student.

Silverwood's primary mission is to educate students. If a family is having difficulty making tuition payments, *please* contact the Head of School. Financial discussions are treated with confidentiality and compassion at Silverwood School.
